Example: If you receive \$25 in Chamber Gift Check and use it at any location above that accepts Chamber Gift Checks, then the business gets to deposit that check in their business account is if it were a personal check. The person spending/paying with the gift checks aren't out anything! It becomes a win-win situation for both parties.

Disclaimer: The Fleming County Chamber of Commerce does **NOT** profit from the Gift Checks Program. All money goes directly towards the business(es) in which the gift checks are used.

NOTE: It is our recommendation that if someone uses a Gift Check with your business and they do not use the entire amount, that you offer them a store credit/gift card for the remaining balance. This is just a recommendation as this program was designed to support local Chamber Businesses and if you are giving back change, there's no guarantee that the remaining balance will be spent locally. If someone purchases, for an example, a Walmart Gift Card they can only use that gift at Walmart and Walmart does not give back cash on monies remaining on their card. Again, this is only our recommendation. As a business owner you're free to handle the remaining balance from the gift check as you see best.


