

Those on the tour were impressed with ARaymond's production process, the cleanliness of their facility, and their employee safety procedures.



We continued our tour with a stop at the **Fleming-Mason Airport** where we were met by Airport Board Member and Vice President of the FC Chamber of Commerce: Charlie Masters, Executive Director of the Maysville Area Chamber of Commerce: Kaci Compton and several of her members, Mason County Judge Executive: Owen McNeill, BTADD, other members of the airport board. After dividing up into groups where we able to route around to different areas and learn more about the airport and the services and educational programs offered there.

We finished our day with a delicious lunch prepared by Mayslick Dinner Bell and sponsored by the Fleming-Mason Airport Board. Glass with Sass Selected for Governor's Derby Art Exhibit: A Fleming County Sunset

Flemingsburg, KY—Over 120 Kentucky artisans submitted innovative pieces to the Kentucky Arts Council for consideration of the 2024 Governor's Derby Art Exhibit. Only 40 were selected. Among those chosen was local stained glass artist Pam McGlone with her piece titled 'A Fleming County Sunset'.

McGlone, owner of Glass with Sass, is known for creating custom stained glass and mosaic pieces. However, when she heard of this year's theme,

A Commonwealth Landscape, she knew right away that she wanted to create a unique piece that would highlight the beautiful works of art God puts in our Fleming County skies. "I wanted to showcase our beautiful sunsets with rolling hills, but I also wanted every aspect of it to have symbolism to Fleming County and its history," stated McGlone.

The canvas is a wooden plank from the original Goddard Bridge with a #43 medallion stamped on it, indicating the 43rd board in which the bridge was built. Outlined in young soybeans is the state of Kentucky with a foundation of glass from the Kelly House, a tourist landmark in downtown Flemingsburg known for housing wounded civil war soldiers. The rolling hills consist of tobacco stick shavings, seeds from prominent Fleming County crops, and rocks found near the Iwo Jima flag raising memorial. The sun is made of glass from an original Mt. Carmel Christian Church window (late 1800's) and the sunrises are metal strips from an original Odd Fellows building roof tile, built in 1850.

The exhibit will be on display in the Capitol Rotunda May 3rd through July 1st, available for viewing by all visitors to the State Capitol. McGlone's piece will come back to Flemingsburg once the Exhibit ends and will be available for sale, with all proceeds going to the efforts of the local Warrior Women group. "Many people helped to pull this piece together, it was truly a team effort," says McGlone. Special thanks are given to Steve Donovan, Adam Hinton, Crystal Ruark, John Sims, Sr., Kevin Porter, Tracy Mousa and Megan Jones.



The **Fleming County Chamber Gift Check Program** is a **FREE** program to any/all Chamber Members who wish to participate in! **Chamber Gift Checks** can be redeemed at over 60 Chamber Business which are listed above towards the purchase of a Good and/or Service.

Example: If you receive \$25 in Chamber Gift Check and use it at any location above that accepts Chamber Gift Checks, then the business gets to deposit that check in their business account is if it were a personal check. The person spending/paying with the gift checks aren't out anything! It becomes a win-win situation for both parties.

Disclaimer: The Fleming County Chamber of Commerce does NOT profit from the Gift Checks Program.
All money goes directly towards the business(es) in which the gift checks are used.

NOTE: It is our recommendation that if someone uses a Gift Check with your business and they do not use the entire amount, that you offer them a store credit/gift card for the remaining balance. This is just a recommendation as this program was designed to support local Chamber Businesses and if you are giving back change, there's no guarantee that the remaining balance will be spent locally. If someone purchases, for an example, a Walmart Gift Card they can only use that gift at Walmart and Walmart does not give back cash on monies remaining on their card. Again, this is only our recommendation.

As a business owner you're free to handle the remaining balance from the gift check as you see best.


