Fleming County Public Library Construction Continues...

As many of you know the library has been in a construction project since September 2021 which is two parts.

The first being an outdoor pavilion with added parking which is underway and on schedule and the second being a transaction window, which will begin in February. Both projects are targeted for completion in late April 2022.

With the transaction window, they will be moving the book drop to the right of where it is presently, and the transaction drawer will be to the left. Other changes will also be reconfiguration of the parking lot area as you would pull toward the window.

Starting the first week of February, the book drop will be closed for returns, and they will have a temporary drop for materials and keys.


