From the Director...

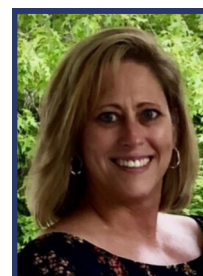

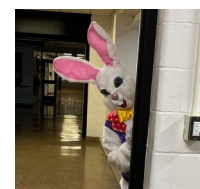

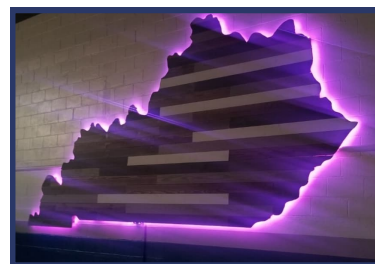

KWI recently achieved two honors with the National Center for Construction, Education and Research (NCCER). KWI has long been accredited with NCCER as an Accredited Training Facility (ATF), but is now an endorsed Accredited Assessment Site for the NCCER's Silver and Gold card certifications. Legislation passed a few years ago requires that crane operators now be nationally certified. To aid industry with this new requirement and to give KWI students the option at training and certification that will help them on the job site, KWI now offers NCCER Gold training and certification for Rigger, Signal Person and Crane Operators.
